

Subjects

The main subject offered at the Doshisha Summer Session is "Japanese". In addition, classes and field trips related to "Life and Culture in Kyoto" will be offered to expand the students' knowledge. These two subjects are regarded as the core of the program. (A certain level of proficiency in Japanese is required, as all classes will be conducted in Japanese.)

Placement

At the time of application, participants are asked to fill in a Japanese proficiency questionnaire that is used for provisional placement. Each class is usually kept to a small group of seven to ten students. Final placement will be made according to the result of the placement test held at the beginning of the program.

Japanese

Detailed instruction will be given depending on the levels of each participant. This subject aims to develop comprehensive language abilities of conversation, grammar, listening and writing.

Life and Culture in Kyoto

With field trips and hands-on experiences in this subject, participants will have an opportunity to apply the skills they have acquired in the "Japanese" class, as well as to deepen their understanding of the life, culture and society of the people in Japan, and in Kyoto in particular. In many towns in the Kansai-district, including Kyoto, various traditional cultures, arts and conventional lifestyle have been inherited in their long history. Participants will have in-depth insight into Japan as a country through these field trips and activities.

Support by Doshisha Students

Supporting system by Doshisha students is ready to assist participants in studying easy in mind. The system assists participants in any aspects such as extracurricular activities and supporting participants' daily lives.

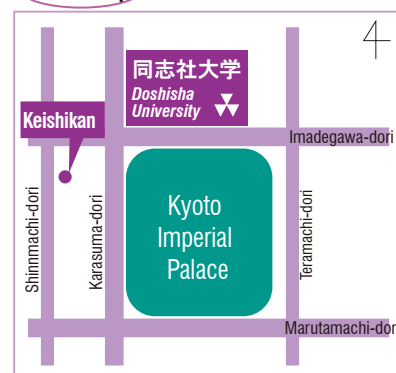

How to apply

Requirements

- ①A basic level of Japanese proficiency (those who can at least read Hiragana, Katakana, and give a brief self-introduction in Japanese)
※Those with no previous knowledge of Japanese cannot apply.
- ②High school diploma or above
- ③Ability to obtain a valid visa on their own
※Priority will be given to students from Doshisha's partner institutions in case the number of applicants exceeds the quota.
※Those who are living in Japan can also apply, in which case the fees should be paid within Japan.
