■ Eligible students

Undergraduate/Graduate International (Regular, Special) Students with “Beginner Level” on Japanese Language Placement Test (not eligible whose Japanese Language level is I or higher)

*This course is not for ILA students.

■ Instructions for Course Enrollment

- ① Take the Japanese Language Placement Test –online–
(10:00am, August 24th ~ 9:00am, August 26th)
- ② Receive a Japanese Level Notification email (placed in “Beginner Level” ※)
- ③ Apply for the Class Placement Interview for Japanese Language Introductory Course
- ④ Take the Class Placement Interview at your main campus –on site–
 - Imadegawa Campus: October 6th(Tue) 3:15pm - (JST)
 - Kyotanabe Campus: October 5th(Mon) 1:30pm - (JST)
- ⑤ Apply for the Introductory Course you assigned

Every Tuesday and Thursday 【Classes begin on October 20th】

Class A 3:15pm-4:25pm, B 4:40pm-5:50pm, C 6:15pm-7:25pm (JST)

- Kyotanabe campus:

Class A 1:30pm-2:40pm, B 2:55pm-4:05pm, C 4:30pm-5:40pm (JST)

※ Students who are placed in level I or higher are not eligible for this course.
